1. Explore the town of Iwase, which thrived as a port for Kitamae ships from the late Edo period to the Meiji era. Walk through the historic streets lined with merchant houses and experience the port town with the guidance of a local guide.
*Kitamae-ships are cargo ships that sailed the Japan Sea during the Edo period.
2. Enjoy local sake at "Saseki," a standing bar run by Masuda Sake Brewery, a long-established sake maker in Iwase!
