### Greeting

The International Conference on High Pressure Science and Technology (AIRAPT) is an interdisciplinary international conference focusing on fields such as physics, chemistry, earth and planetary sciences, materials science, fluid science, life sciences, and food science, utilizing high pressure as a key methodology. Since its first conference in France in 1965, the conference has been held approximately every two years for nearly 60 years, primarily in Europe, the United States, and Asia, typically with 500 to 800 participants from over 30 countries. In Japan, the AIRAPT conference was held in Kyoto (1974, 1997) and Tokyo (2009). The 29th AIRAPT will be held in Matsuyama City, Ehime Prefecture, from September 28 to October 3, 2025, as a joint conference with the 66th High Pressure Conference of Japan (HPCJ) and the 11th Asian Conference on High Pressure Research (ACHPR).

In early 2024, an organizing committee, primarily comprising members of the Japan Society of High Pressure Science and Technology, was established. A local executive committee, mainly composed of members from Ehime University was also established and has been actively preparing for the conference. Hosting an international conference with over 500 participants in a rural city like Matsuyama is a rare occurrence. The conference has received strong support from organizations such as the Matsuyama Convention and Visitors Bureau and has gained significant recognition, including the 2023 International Conference Bid Assistance Award from the Japan National Tourism Organization (JNTO). Anticipation for AIRAPT-29 is steadily growing in the host city.

The conference will offer corporate exhibitions, advertisements on the website, and ads in the abstract book. Donations from individuals and organizations are also welcome. We kindly invite you to join us in supporting this important conference, to contribute to the further advancement of High Pressure science and technology in Japan.
