Japanese Sword Forging Experience

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『Blade House Sanshu – Seki Blade Museum』

The Seki Blade Museum, opened within the cutlery shop Sanshu under the concept of an ‘experiential complex facility,’ features exhibits using actual tools to demonstrate the manufacturing processes of kitchen knives and Japanese swords produced in Seki City. It includes a Japanese sword forging workshop enclosed in transparent acrylic, where visitors can observe (for a fee) the forging of Japanese swords by master swordsmith Fujiwara Kanemasa up close.

『 Japanese Sword Forging Experience 』

This is a unique opportunity to observe the Japanese sword forging techniques of the 25th and 26th generation master swordsmiths of the Fujiwara no Kanefusa lineage, a tradition dating back to the Muromachi period. They have crafted swords for the Tokugawa family for generations and also forged swords for successive Yokozuna sumo wrestlers. Participants can actually experience forging themselves, wielding a large hammer. Additionally, you'll hear directly from the swordsmith about the process of making a sword—an experience you won't find anywhere else.

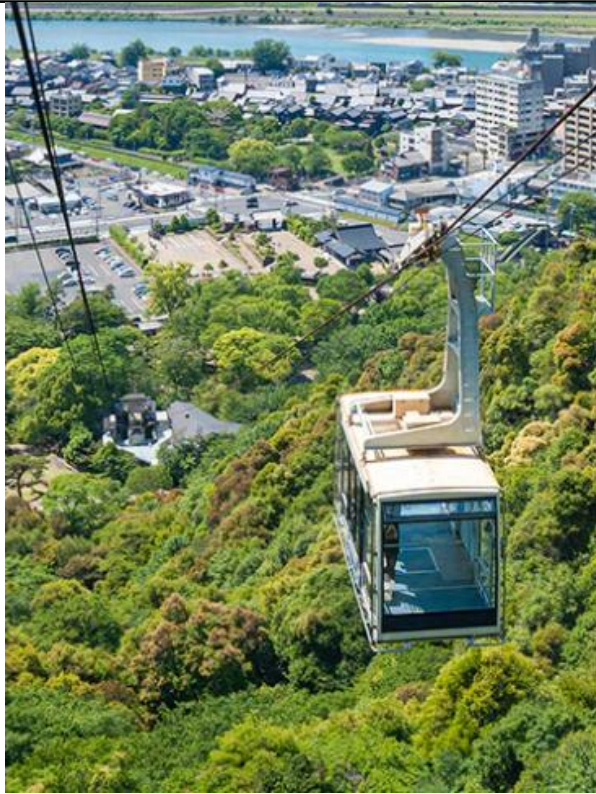

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『Gifu Kinkazan (Mt. Kinka) Ropeway (Cable Car) 』

The Gifu Kinkazan Ropeway connects the base station in Gifu Park to the summit station atop Mount Kinkazan in approximately 4 minutes.

From the train window, you can enjoy panoramic views of Mt. Kinkazan covered in natural forests, the natural beauty of the Nagara River, and the cityscape of Gifu City.

『Nobunaga Terrace』

Nobunaga Terrace, a rental space located directly below the observation restaurant. Its full-length glass windows can be opened completely, offering an open, airy feel. It is available for group dining, meetings, and other gatherings.

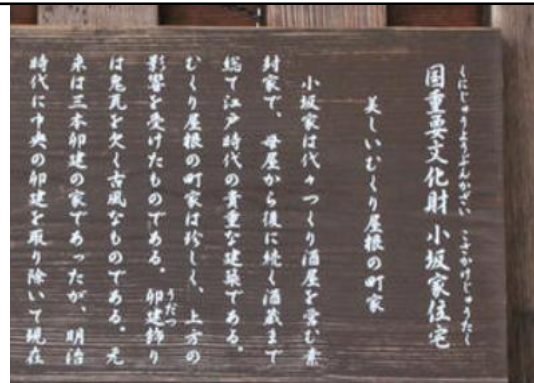

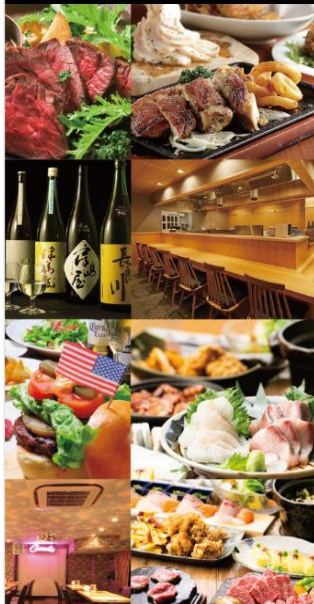

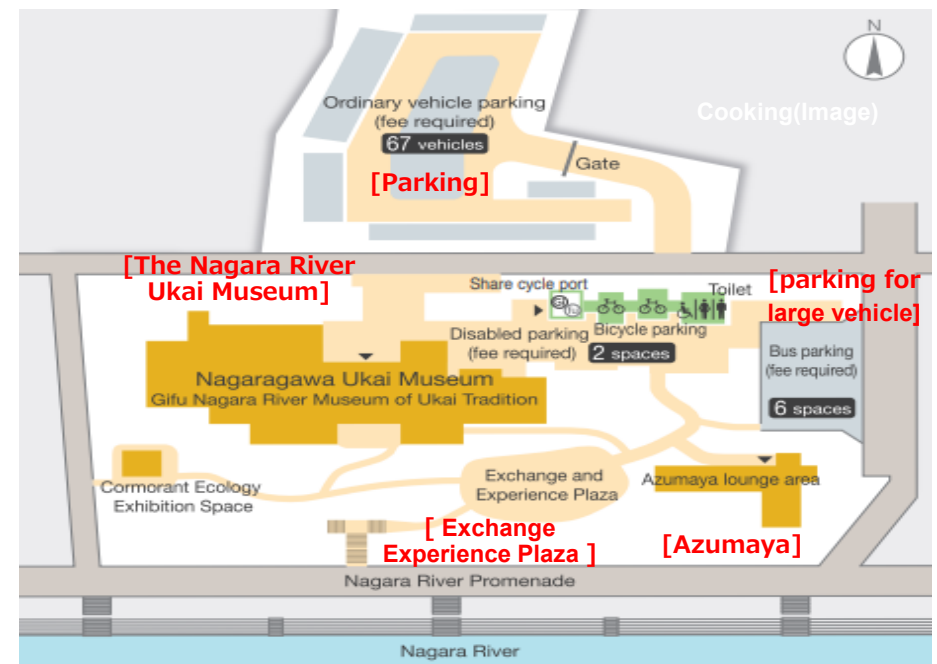
